

## Statewide Individual Service Competition

**Purpose:** To encourage and reward those who give back to the community in the name of the Junior Classical League. These students and schools are exceptional in their efforts whether it be in the amount of time dedicated to service, the creativity of their service opportunities, or the execution and effectiveness of a service event.

**Guidelines:** Individuals will digitally submit a summary of their hours and events which were service AND Junior Classical League related (e.g. statewide service events, chapter service events, integration of service into chapter/state/community activities). This digital entry will be released a month prior to State Convention and submissions will be judged by the 2nd VP in coherence with the 1st VP and president when necessary.

**Scoring:** Submissions will be scored holistically and subjectively, with special attention to and a point system for: number of hours served, creativity of ideas, overall effectiveness, and picture submissions.

### Point System:

*Number of Hours Served:* Each hour = one point

*Creativity of Ideas:* Scale system, 1 being generic, 5 being extremely creative

Scoring Example:

- 1- Can Drive
- 2- Can Drive at chapter party
- 3- Can Drive at Fall Forum carpool
- 4- Can Drive in Togas
- 5- Can Drive competition with the lowest number of can collectors having to wear a toga all day at school

*Overall Effectiveness:* Scale system, 1 being not very effective, 5 being extremely effective

Scoring Example (ratios subject to change):

- 1- 10 cans collected in JCL of 30 people
- 2- 30 cans collected in JCL of 30 people
- 3- 60 cans collected in JCL of 30 people
- 4- 100 cans collected in JCL of 30 people
- 5- 300 cans collected in JCL of 30 people

*Picture Submissions:* 1 picture = 1 point, cap at 10 pictures, +2 points for excellent\* pictures

\*Excellent pictures are taken with a camera (not a phone) and effectively portray the volunteer opportunity.

*Holistic Rating:* Scale of 1 to 10, no criteria just overall quality of the submission.
